## ALASKA BIG GAME COMMERCIAL SERVICES BOARD GUIDE-OUTFITTER CONTRACT

Alaska State law (AS 08.54.680 and 12 AAC 75.260) requires a big game Registered Guide-Outfitter to provide a written contract to document services being provided and items for which the client is responsible. A contract shall be delivered to the client within 90 days after receipt of deposit, or before services are provided, whichever is earlier. The contract must include the following:
